Sir,

We have received from the British Consul in Munich your very interesting letter of October 14th, and we are very interested to hear that you are preparing an exhibition of Town Planning in Munich.

We have assured the British Consul that we are at all times ready to help where possible in the re-establishment of those very wide international contacts which we had before the war. At the moment, however, I am afraid that there is very little indeed that we can do in this matter. We have a large amount of leeway to make up in the establishment of our exhibition organisation, and I am afraid it will be some time before we would be in a position to produce anything on the lines which you require. We suggest, therefore, that the matter may be left over for a time, with the possibility of its being rediscussed at a future date.
