

## Your author contract (single work) with TUM.University Press

In this overview we have summarized the most important aspects of the publishing contract. Please note: Only the contract itself is legally binding.

- Depending on the contract, we publish your text as a printed book or as a printed book and a digital open-access PDF.
- Your work will be featured on the TUM. University Press website and will be available in various online stores (e. g., Lehmanns) as well as brick-and-mortar bookstores.
- For the print edition, you grant us the simple right to reproduce and distribute your work.
  These are the minimum rights we need for publishing and distributing. You can still use your
  text in other contexts (e. g. as a secondary publication in a journal). After 5 years, TUM.UP
  may offer further storage, but is not obliged to do so.
- For the digital Open-Access edition, you grant us, the Bavarian State Library and the German National Library simple right to reproduce, distribute and edit it. These are the minimum rights required for the distribution of your work.
- No third-party rights may be infringed (e. g. in the case of illustrations). TUM.University
  Press is happy to provide advice in this regard, but does not offer image editing or rights
  collection.
- If your book was produced by digital printing, you can order additional copies of your work with a discount of 35 % within 5 years after conclusion of contract.
